## **Biblical Definitions**

For much of the history of this modern church age, Christians have not grasped the idea of God speaking through Biblical numerology. Some have called particular cases of this, **RNS** or **Rhema Numerical Synchronicity**. Part of the reason Christians are typically opposed to this is because other people have used numerology in demonic ways, pointing people to mysticism, instead of the Lord Jesus and God's plan of saving them. However, we should not allow their sin to cut us off from hearing God by faith, assuming He *may be* speaking to us His own numerical way.

The Scriptures declare that God gave the heavens for signs. Astrologers give them a different intended definition, but the word of God is still true. They are there for signs. It is the same with biblical numerology.

**Single Digit Numerology:** What follows is an incomplete table of numbers and their Biblical meanings. I must disclaim, however, that these are the only meanings. I have come against some contradictions when looking up the meanings of some numbers. Don't take any of these numbers to the bank unless you've confirmed it with at least two to three "Adequate Witness."

Some examples from The Companion Bible:

**FOUR** - Denotes *creative works*, and always has reference to the material creation, as pertaining to the *earth*, and things "under the sun", and things terrestrial.

**SEVEN** - Denotes *spiritual perfection*. It is the hall-mark of the Holy Spirit's work. He is the Author of God's Word, and seven is stamped on it as the water mark is seen in the manufacture of paper. He is the Author and Giver of *life*; and seven is the number which regulates every period of incubation and gestation, in insects, birds, animals, and man.

**EIGHT** - Denotes resurrection, regeneration, a new beginning or commencement. The eighth is a new first. Hence the octave in music, color, days of the week. This is, therefore, the *Dominical* number. By Gematria (the addition of the numerical value of the letters together) the Greek letters for Jesus makes the numbers 888. It, or its multiple is impressed on all that has to do with the Lord's Names, the Lord's People, and the Lord's works.

**Numerical Sequences:** From a biblical perspective, triple digits like, 666, 777, 888 are multiples of 111. These *triple figures* (a triad with three of the same numbers) is simply a way of emphasizing their root – single digit - meanings. Thus, **111** emphasizes the meaning of the number **one**, and so forth.

The 444 that you see, is a representation of the fourth dimension as seen from a perspective of the third dimension. You are moving into the fourth dimension. **888=** Multiplied meaning of 8 - Holy Spirit; The sum of Tree of Life - is the number of a 'new creation', (i.e., 'a new man'). It is Jesus' number because the name *Jesus* adds up to 888 in Gematria in contrast to fallen man's number of 666 (Rev. 13). Moreover, Jesus received His name when He was eight days old on the day that He was circumcised! (Luke 2:21.) (Note, the 'names on foreheads' in Rev. 13:18 in contrast with the next verse, 14:1.)

**Secular Numerology – Characteristics:**

**8=** Achievement, abundance, executive, strength, self-disciplined, power, success, authority, psychology, entrepreneur, intensity, supervisor, provider, grandeur, material manifestor.

**Signals:**

**888=** A phase of your life is about to end and this is a sign to give you forewarning to prepare. This number sequence may mean you are winding up an emotional, career, or relationship phase.



**Biblical Meanings:**

**9=** Fruit of the spirit; Divine completeness from the Father

**999=** Multiplied meaning of 9

**Secular Numerology – Characteristics:**

**9=** Endings, completion, humanitarian, compassionate, romantic, selfless, generous, philanthropic, loving, wisdom, idealist, artistic, spiritual healer, all allowing, other worldly, blending.

**999=** Completion. This is the end of a big phase in your personal or global life. Your thoughts at the time of seeing this sign indicate that these thoughts will bring about the completion or end of a phase in your life.
